SANITARY GUIDELINES AS OF JUNE 8, 2020

We are thankful to be able to offer a place to escape outdoors while practicing safe social distancing. We ask all members and guests to help us by abiding by these additional safety and sanitation measures when you choose to visit us:

- We encourage practicing social distancing and highly recommend staying 6 feet away from others at all times.
- Gatherings of 8 or more persons within the pro shop is prohibited, which may require our members and guests being asked to wait outside at certain times.
- In order to further limit gathering and extended time spent inside the golf shop, we ask for payment via credit/debit card when calling to make tee time reservations, or for players to call us upon arrival to check-in and process payment over the phone. We will not be accepting cash payments at this time.
- Members may call or notify the starter in order to check-in for their tee time.
- Cart keys, range balls, and other merchandise may be purchased and picked up within the pro-shop in person, but we ask patrons to limit the amount of time spent inside the golf shop as much as possible.
- Tee times are scheduled in 15 minute intervals.
- Walking is encouraged.
- Bunker rakes have been removed from the bunkers on course.
- DO NOT touch or remove the flag stick on putting greens. Cups have been modified to permit easy removal of balls without touching the flag stick or cup.
- The GHIN scoring station has been removed from the golf shop, and we encourage golfers to record their scores at home until further notice.

We are actively sanitizing all frequently touched areas in and around the clubhouse including all doors, knobs, railings, bathrooms (including on course), golf carts and bag stands. We will continue to monitor the guidelines and restrictions put in place by VDH in order to preserve the health and safety of our patrons and staff, and we reserve the right to make further adjustments to our business operations as needed.
